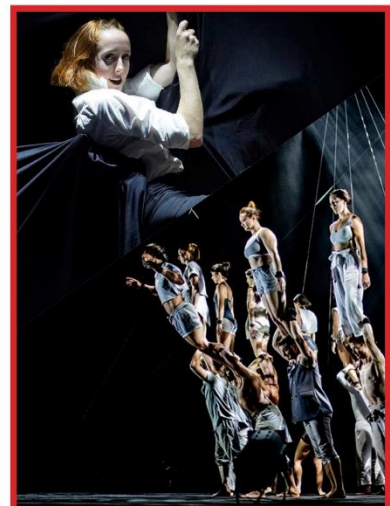

These are just some of the reasons why you should consider partnering with us to bring to life our Regional Cinema Tour:

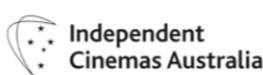
- ✓ Bring arts to the community, and community to the arts
